Northwest Ohio is unique in that, according to the Regional Growth Partnership, it is the only metropolitan area in the USA with every form of transportation available – rail, road, sea, and air. And, within a 300 mile radius of Toledo, the region has access to the most industrial square footage in the United States and Canada.

The Logistics and Supply Chain major equips students with the technical skills to begin their careers in the fast growing field of logistics and supply chain management. In addition to the technical courses, general education courses develop students to be prepared to deal with all kinds of issues that confront them in the performance of their jobs.

## JOB OPPORTUNITIES FOR GRADUATES

This major will prepare students for entry level supervisory positions and/or staff positions in the logistics/supply chain industry. Positions can include, but are not limited to, the following: supervisors and managers of production operation workers, construction trades and extract workers, and managers of transportation, storage, or distribution. Our classes can also help prepare you for the certification as a Certified Logistics Associate (CLA).

### **SALARY**

The U.S. Department of Labor, Bureau of Labor Statistics for the Toledo area, reports annual salaries for positions such as those listed above range from \$69,500 to \$99,840.

The Ohio Department of Jobs and Family Services estimates that the demand for workers in the transportation and warehousing industry in Northwest Ohio will grow 1.5 - 8.2% between 2022 through 2032.
