

The Theatre Transfer Pathway is designed for students with an interest in theatre performance who intend to transfer to a four-year institution to complete a bachelor's degree in theatre. Transfer institutions may require different courses for this transfer program. Students should tailor their Owens program as closely as possible to the requirements at their four-year school of choice. Meet with an advisor for more information.

This program provides its majors with a variety of courses in acting and technical theatre.

Theatre majors will take a wide range of courses from acting and script analysis to stagecraft. Students will have the opportunity to apply these skills by auditioning for roles in student productions each fall and spring semester. Winners of student production roles also will be awarded performance scholarships. Productions have included "Romeo and Juliet," "She Kills Monsters" and "Next to Normal."

Theatre Express is another opportunity for students and faculty to collaborate on new works. Each fall semester, the Theatre Program hosts a festival of 10-minute plays that are written, rehearsed and performed in a 24-hour time frame. Sure to challenge any future actor or playwright.
