With the expansion of motion graphics in marketing and entertainment, Animation is growing career. Students now have the opportunity to learn about a wide range of career options in a common first semester shared by students in Visual Communication and Commercial Photography followed by three semesters of engaging coursework in Digital Media, Character Animation, 2D Animation and 3D Animation.

The Animation Major trains students in multiple techniques used by industry professionals to produce animation for motion graphics, digital media, advertising, entertainment, gaming and visual communications. Students will understand fundamental principles of illustration, typography and graphic design as well as the application of 2D and 3D animation principles as they relate to the digital media industry. As motion graphics continues to expand in the world of marketing, animators will be a key component in media design.

Students with an interest in marketing, design and animation will find this program engaging and applicable to their career interests. Students work on projects throughout the course of study building portfolios and demo reels to showcase their work. A fourth semester internship provides students with hands-on experience, gaining knowledge and a practical application of skills in a professional environment.

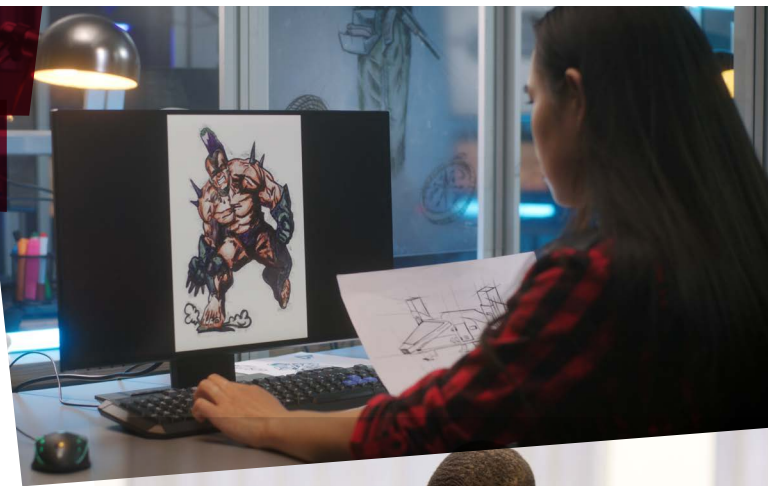
