Owens Instructor Buchanan Receives National Faculty Award

Owens Community College Dental Hygiene Instructor <u>Nicole Buchanan</u> has been recognized by the American Association of Community Colleges (AACC) as a 2024 Dale P. Parnell Distinguished Faculty recipient.

Awarded to select faculty who make a difference in community college classrooms across the country, this highly competitive national designation honors faculty active in their students' lives and in their colleges' activities to ensure student success. Buchanan is the fourth Owens faculty member to receive the AACC accolade, joining Sara Burke, Jen Hazel and Sarah Long.

"I love teaching at the college that gave me my career," Buchanan said. "I love working with students and find it deeply rewarding. I am lucky to be doing what I am passionate about."

Besides her position at Owens, the Elmore resident works for dental practices in Perrysburg and Toledo. She earned her bachelor's degree from Bowling Green State University (2014) and master's in public health from the Northwest Ohio Consortium for Public Health (2018).

In addition to the Parnell Award, Buchanan received the <u>Owens School of Nursing and Health Professions</u> <u>Teaching Excellence Award</u> after the 2022-2023 academic year.

Owens Receives Ohio Reach Postsecondary Designation

The <u>Designation</u> recognizes campuses meeting criteria that depict their support of students with experience in foster care or kinship.

Owens Community College is proud to be one of twelve campuses to receive the <u>Ohio Reach Postsecondary Designation on</u> <u>April 30, 2024</u>. The total number of Ohio campuses that have earned the designation is now 40. The initial cohort was announced last August, and 111 Ohio Reach students have since been identified through the designation to receive support services.

Ohio Reach is a network of professionals, advocates, and students across Ohio determined to support former foster youth on their education journey. Ohio Reach, administered through the Ohio Children's Alliance, provides resources to institutions of higher education, child welfare agencies, and foster care alumni enrolled in higher education to support their academic success.
