FOR LIFE-THREATENING SITUATIONS, CALL 9-1-1 IMMEDIATELY

FIRST ASK: Is the person a **DANGER** to themselves or others?

2

YES

Examples of Specific Behaviors

- Expresses intent of harm to self or others or indicates others are planning to harm them
- Expresses anger for being treated unfairly and talks about revenge/vengeance
- Is agitated or extremely upset (hitting tables, restless, pacing, etc.)
- Is exceedingly argumentative, especially with increasing profanity
- Engages in highly disruptive behavior (hostility, aggression, violence, etc.)

NOT SURE

Examples of Specific Behaviors

- Reports being depressed
- Expresses hopelessness
- Is impaired
- Is verbally harassing or intimidating others
- Has frequent conflicts with others
- Displays prohibited behavior covered by the Student Code of Conduct or Board policies

2

NO

Examples of Specific Behaviors

- Reports poor grades
- Reports lack of resources such as food, housing, childcare, etc.
- Reports employment issues
- Reports emotional issues such as family or personal crisis, mental health concern, or disability concern
