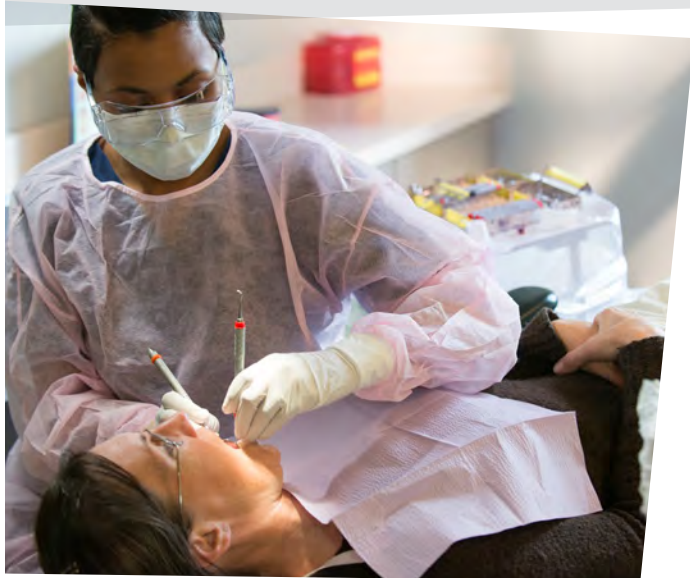




Dental Hygiene Clinic

Owens Community College's Dental Hygiene Program operates a Dental Hygiene Clinic for community members to receive **safe, quality dental services at a reasonable cost**. The Clinic is open to adults and children and is staffed by dental hygiene students and supervised by licensed dental professionals. Students have had extensive education prior to their clinical experience. The 21-chair clinic runs September through May.



COST

\$35 Community members
\$25 Owens employees and students
\$5 Children age three or younger
All ages welcome!

COST INCLUDES

- Oral assessments
- Radiographs (X-rays)
- Cleaning, scaling, root planing, polishing
- Topical fluoride
- Patient instruction and home care kit

Preventive treatment appointments are made during students' class time and are two to three hours in length (in some cases, adult appointments can require several visits that are included in the fee).

CLIENT RESPONSIBILITIES

If you need to cancel an appointment, please notify the Dental Hygiene Clinic at least 24 hours in advance. Excessive cancellations by patients may reduce opportunities for further services at the Dental Hygiene Clinic.

PAYMENT FOR SERVICES

Fees cover the expense of supplies used during treatment and must be paid at the first appointment before treatment begins.

LOCATION

The Dental Hygiene Clinic is located in Health Technologies Hall on the Toledo-area Campus. Just five minutes from downtown Toledo, the campus is easy to find. Take I-75 to exit 198 (Wales Road exit) and turn right on Oregon Road. The five-story Health Technologies building is marked by the O on top. The Clinic is in room 207.
