Main Gallery

The 1,300 square foot gallery has been proud to host one person exhibits with such well known contemporary artists as Lorna Simpson, Judy Chicago and Donald Woodman, Mary Ellen Mark, Beverly McIver, Zack Booth Simpson, Christo and Jeanne Claude, and Therman Statom. We have also showcased the work of renowned local artists, among them Ken Thompson, Jack Schmidt and Leslie Adams. In a recent show, "The Collector and the Artist", we were able to include African antiquities, Henry Moore, Georges Rouault, Francesco Clemente, Robert Motherwell, Louise Bourgeois, and Richard Estes in our exhibition schedule.

Outside Wall Gallery

Located on the exterior wall of the Main Gallery, the Gallery Outside is appreciated by hundreds of visitors daily. The Gallery Outside showcases flat works of art including paintings, photographs and wall sculptures on its 45 running feet. Frequently the exhibitions are curated to support the content of the exhibits in the Main Gallery.

Proposal Process

The Gallery Committee will review proposals from individuals or groups. Individuals may be exhibited with other artists depending on media (2-D/3-D) subject matter and space limitations.

Interested parties should submit the following material

1. Cover Letter/Proposal that describes the work and includes contact info.
2. Artist(s) bio(s).
3. Artist(s) resume(s)
4. Artist statement(s)
5. 10-20 images of the work. Images should be JPG files that are 1200 pixels on the longest side. Images should be numbered and named with the artists last name, and a brief title/descriptive word: EX: <01_Smith_Portrait.jpg>
6. Image List. Numbered list of the submitted images that corresponds to the file numbers and includes full title, media, dimensions, sale price or insurance value, any unique hanging instructions.
7. Not Required but Desirable: Workshop or Artist lecture Proposal. Preference may be given to artists who can provide additional educational experience to Owens Students and Community members.

Please submit all documents as PDF files. Please name all documents with Artists last name and a descriptive term: EX: <Smith_Resume.pdf>
