## BUSINESS TRANSFER CONCENTRATION

### Associate of Science

Some students desire to earn a bachelor's degree but also want to utilize the convenience, low cost, and programs offered at Owens Community College. If a bachelor's degree is your goal, the Business Administration Concentration may be right for you.

#### TRANSFER OPTIONS:

This program is intended to provide the student with the first two years of a baccalaureate degree. Students then transfer to a four-year college or university to pursue a bachelor's degree in a business discipline, such as accounting, finance, marketing, management or human resource management.

#### JOB OPPORTUNITIES FOR GRADUATES

Depending upon the discipline selected, a student may seek employment in general management training, small business or entrepreneurial firms, or larger employers within a specific industry such as technology, healthcare, manufacturing, service, or automotive.
