Graduates will be prepared for placement in child care centers, Head Start Centers, public schools, preschools, public preschool paraprofessional programs or other programs involved in the care and guidance of prekindergarten children and their families. An option to classroom teaching includes work as a Head Start Home Visitor, Family Engagement Advocate or Health and Disabilities Advocate.

The Bureau of Labor Statistics projects a 6 percent job growth for preschool teachers through 2024.
