

# ASSOCIATE OF ARTS, GENERAL CONCENTRATION

## Associate of Arts

This concentration is designed to prepare students for transfer to a four-year college or university and is the equivalent of the freshman and sophomore years of a Bachelor of Arts Degree program. For students who do not have a decided interest in one field of study, the concentration provides a broad knowledge of liberal arts. Elective courses give the student the flexibility to choose from a number of transferable courses.

### TRANSFER PARTNERS

Transfer institutions may require different courses for this transfer program. Students should tailor their Owens program as closely as possible to the requirements at their four-year school of choice. Meet with an Advisor for more information.

### JOB OPPORTUNITIES FOR 4-YEAR GRADUATES

Those graduating with their Bachelor of Arts degree tend to be sought out by employers because of their broad base education that has shaped inquiring minds. Students who graduate with their Art degree find they have learned very valuable employable skills such as, research, creativity, critical thinking and analysis, and effective communication and interpersonal skills.

### SALARY

Salaries in the area of Arts are dependent on several variables such as, the chosen industry, size of employer, the area or region where the employer is located, and work experience.

Types of areas a graduate could work in are visual and performing arts, communication disorders sciences and services, studio art, social work, human services, community organizations, theology, early childhood education, and psychology.
