Owens Community College Major: Education Transfer Concentration

Program Length: 4 semesters **Credits:** 60-65

PROGRAM INFORMATION

The Education Transfer Concentration provides the first two years of study for students who want to teach in public school, pre-kindergarten through grade twelve. After receiving the Associate of Arts Degree, students should plan to transfer to a college or university offering a bachelor's degree in education. Completion of the bachelor's degree leads to Teacher Licensure in the State of Ohio. Students should not confuse this concentration with Owens' Early Childhood Education program for students primarily intending to seek employment upon graduation in a childcare center, Head Start Center or public paraprofessional preschool.

JOB OPPORTUNITIES FOR GRADUATES

Graduates will be prepared to transfer to a university where they will complete a bachelor's degree in education, which is required to teach in the public schools. Some transfer options include Bowling Green State University, Lourdes University, University of Findlay, and University of Toledo.

SALARY

The U.S. Department of Labor, Bureau of Statistics for the Toledo area, reports annual salaries for positions such as special education, kindergarten, elementary education, middle or secondary education range from \$35,000 to \$57,000.

TECH PREP SCHOLARSHIP

Owens Community College offers Tech Prep scholarships to graduating high school seniors who have participated in a Tech Prep career pathway within the Greater Northwest Ohio Tech Prep Consortium. The maximum award is \$2,000 total (\$1,000 per year) or \$500 per semester for four semesters to cover tuition, fees, and an allotment for books **that are not covered** by other financial aid, such as Federal Pell Grant, as long as the student maintains eligibility. This scholarship does not pay for supplies, lab fees, course fees, and other institutional fees. Students must earn a 2.5 on a 4.0 GPA scale by the end of the 7th semester of high school. They must enroll at Owens, full time, for the fall semester immediately following high school graduation, and declare an associate degree program related to the chosen high school Tech Prep pathway.
