PROGRAM INFORMATION

Do you want to be a leader? Is management of people or a business of interest to you? If so, majoring in Business Management Technology could be the program for you. Every business needs skilled managers to deal with day-to-day operations as well as planning/implementing long-range goals to remain competitive in today's marketplace. In addition to technical courses, general education courses develop students to be prepared to deal with all kinds of issues that confront them in the performance of their jobs.

JOB OPPORTUNITIES FOR GRADUATES

Students with a Business Management degree are prepared to work in a diverse number of fields including general management, human resource management, management in the retail, restaurant, and health care industries as well as managerial positions in other business operations and government services.

SALARY

The U.S. Department of Labor, Bureau of Statistics for the Toledo area, reports annual salaries for positions such as those listed above range from \$34,330 to \$87,610.

The Ohio Department of Jobs and Family Services estimates that the demand for workers in the positions described above will grow from 3.4% to 25% between 2010 and 2020.

TECH PREP SCHOLARSHIP

Owens Community College offers Tech Prep scholarships to graduating high school seniors who have participated in a Tech Prep career pathway within the Greater Northwest Ohio Tech Prep Consortium. The maximum award is \$2,000 total (\$1,000 per year) or \$500 per semester for four semesters to cover tuition, fees, and an allotment for books **that are not covered** by other financial aid, such as Federal Pell Grant, as long as the student maintains eligibility. This scholarship does not pay for supplies, lab fees, course fees, and other institutional fees. Students must earn a 2.5 on a 4.0 GPA scale by the end of the 7th semester of high school. They must enroll at Owens, full time, for the fall semester immediately following high school graduation, and declare an associate degree program related to the chosen high school Tech Prep pathway.
