PROGRAM INFORMATION

Do you enjoy working with numbers? If so, a degree in Accounting Technology may be perfect for you. Develop the technical skills needed to work in a variety of accounting-related careers. In addition to the technical courses, general education courses develop students to be prepared to deal with all kinds of issues that might confront them in the performance of their jobs. This program is accredited by the Accreditation Council for Business Schools and Programs (ACBSP).

JOB OPPORTUNITIES FOR GRADUATES

Upon completion of this curriculum, students have acquired fundamental accounting skills that prepare them for employment in a variety of positions including but not limited to: bookkeepers, payroll clerks, bill and account collectors, auditing clerks, accounts receivable/payable clerks, and tax preparers.

SALARY

The U.S. Department of Labor, Bureau of Statistics for the Toledo area, reports annual salaries for positions such as those listed above range from \$31,140 to \$42,710.

The Ohio Department of Jobs and Family Services estimates that the demand for workers in the accounting and auditing fields in Ohio will grow 25.6% between 2010 and 2020. For workers in the areas of bookkeeping, accounting and auditing clerks, Ohio jobs are expected to increase 13.2% between 2010 and 2020.

TECH PREP SCHOLARSHIP

Owens Community College offers Tech Prep scholarships to graduating high school seniors who have participated in a Tech Prep career pathway within the Greater Northwest Ohio Tech Prep Consortium. The maximum award is \$2,000 total (\$1,000 per year) or \$500 per semester for four semesters to cover tuition, fees, and an allotment for books **that are not covered** by other financial aid, such as Federal Pell Grant, as long as the student maintains eligibility. This scholarship does not pay for supplies, lab fees, course fees, and other institutional fees. Students must earn a 2.5 on a 4.0 GPA scale by the end of the 7th semester of high school. They must enroll at Owens, full time, for the fall semester immediately following high school graduation, and declare an associate degree program related to the chosen high school Tech Prep pathway.
