## Helpful Transfer Information

- Owens students are empowered to make informed decisions about the transfer path that is best for them.
- Students should regularly meet with their Owens academic advisor and the transfer admissions representative to best prepare for transfer.
- It is the student's responsibility to keep up with any changes required for their degree at their desired transfer institution.
- Some courses needed for an Owens degree may not transfer to a four-year college/university for a similar major.

- [Transferology](#) is a free website to see how courses will transfer.
- [Ohio Transfer 36](#) classes are general education courses by category for state colleges/universities in Ohio and are useful for students who want to transfer but are not sure their desired major or university.
- [Transfer Assurance Guides](#) are specific courses that will transfer to a state college/university in Ohio for a specific major and are useful for students who know their desired major.
- [Ohio Guaranteed Transfer Pathways](#) outline the degree path for specific majors from an associate degree to a bachelor's degree for state colleges/universities in Ohio.

## Transferability and Applicability

- Transferability means the four-year college/university will award the transfer credit.
- Applicability means the transferred course fulfills a course requirement at the four-year college/university for the student's desired major.

## Value of an Associate Degree

- Provides a valuable credential for job searching and career advancement.
- May eliminate the need for general education courses at a four-year college/university.
- May qualify a student for scholarships at a four-year college/university.
- Reverse transfer may be an option to complete a degree by transferring four-year college/university credits back to Owens. [owens.edu/transfer/reverse](https://owens.edu/transfer/reverse)

- What classes should I take at my current institution that will transfer to your school for my major?
  - What are your admissions requirements and deadlines for transfer students?
  - What scholarships/financial aid do you offer for transfer students?
  - What is the application process for transfer students?
