Fitness Facility Membership

PROCEDURES:

I. Paid Membership Application

- a. To apply for a fitness facility membership, an individual must complete an online membership application (which includes a liability release and indemnification) and make payment for a membership. Payments will only be accepted online.
- b. When the application and payment are verified, an individual can obtain a college-issued identification card to be granted access to the fitness facilities. Please visit in-person at the Department of Public Safety. Locations, hours and contact information may be found online. Link: https://www.owens.edu/dps/
- c. At the fitness facility front desk, all users must present a valid, college-issued identification card to enter the facility. At any time, the college-issued identification card must be presented, upon request by any college authority.

II. Membership Rate Schedule

Type of Membership	Annual Rate
Faculty/Staff Plus Membership	\$50 each for spouse or dependent
Alumni or Retiree Membership	\$100.00
Community Membership	\$150.00

- a. A purchased flat-rate fitness membership is annual, non-transferrable, nonrefundable, and non pro rata.
- b. A purchased membership can be terminated, with or without notice, at the sole and exclusive discretion of the College.
- c. The College reserves the right to adjust the membership rate schedule, when deemed necessary and without advance notice.

III. Responsible Use Information

- a. A fitness facility member must be eighteen (18) years of age or older.
- b. A fitness facility member is responsible to abide by all facility rules.
