When enrolling for courses in the Spring 2022 and beyond, student veterans will need to enroll in in-class courses to continue receiving MHA at the current rate. Hybrid courses with an in-class component are considered in-class by the VA. Online courses will cause the housing allowance to pay at 50 percent of what students receive for in-class courses.
