Winning posters can also be seen occasionally, in the background of TV shows and movies about Veterans. Most importantly, the poster will serve as the cover of the official program for the Veterans Day observance at Arlington National Cemetery on November 11, 2022, during which a grateful nation will honor veterans for their service and sacrifices.

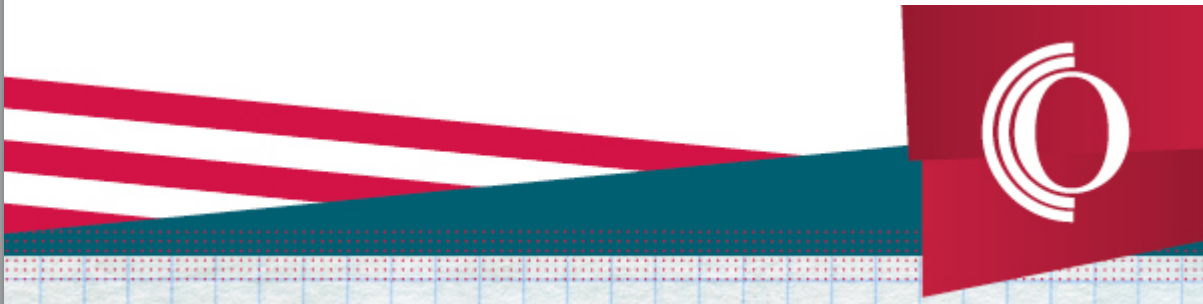
