

Medical Emergencies in the Dental Office

This course is required by the Ohio State Dental Board for the RDH, OHASP RDH, EFDA and CDA dental team, which allows team members to practice when the dentist is not physically present. The course content is on the identification and prevention of medical emergencies in the dental setting. Participants also will learn the importance of preparation, a team approach to medical emergencies, and the medical history interview. The course has been approved by the Ohio State Dental Board and follows the guidelines in the Ohio Revised Codes 4715.22(C)(2), 4715.363(B)(4), 4715.64(C)(2), 4715.39(D)(2)(b).

Course Objectives

- Identify potential medical emergency situations when reviewing medical histories
- Recognize common medical emergency situations
- Prevent emergency situations during dental appointments, including local anesthesia
- Recognize symptoms, first aid treatment and possible outcomes for patients who exhibit bleeding injuries, cardiovascular disease insulin reaction, diabetic coma, shock, syncope, epileptic seizures and allergic reactions
