RN - BSN PROGRAM

- The RN - BSN dual-admission program at Owens Community College and the University of Toledo is the first of its kind in northwest Ohio. You'll earn an associate degree in applied science in nursing from Owens Community College, followed by a bachelor of science in nursing from UToledo. Once you've completed your associate degree at Owens and obtain RN licensure, you'll move seamlessly into nursing courses in UToledo's RN - BSN program, with no additional admission fee.
- The RN - BSN program is completed online through UToledo's Competency-Based Education Program, which provides flexibility to pursue your BSN at your own pace.
- Advisors from both institutions will work with you to make sure you're on track and taking the proper courses to achieve your goals.
- Discover how achievable a BSN can be through the Owens Community College and the University of Toledo dual-admission program.

As you work toward your associate degree at Owens, you'll have access to the same benefits offered to all UToledo students, including:

- Ability to take electives and general education courses
- Free admission to all UToledo athletic home games
