CALL 911



## TORNADO/ SEVERE WEATHER

### SEEK SHELTER

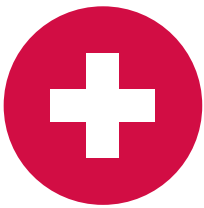
- Monitor local weather.
- Shelter on the lowest level of the building or designated shelter.
- Do not pull the fire alarm.
- Stay away from windows.



## CHEMICAL/ HAZARDOUS SPILL

### CALL 911

- Evacuate the area and/or building.
- Close doors as you leave if safe to do so.
- Wait for an all clear message.



## MEDICAL EMERGENCY

### CALL 911

- Stay on the phone for instructions.
- Stay calm-make sure the scene is safe before rendering aid.
- Move the injured person only if in danger.



## ACTIVE SHOOTER/ HOSTILE INTRUDER

### CALL 911

- Try to safely escape area.
- Hide and barricade if cannot escape.
- Lock doors if possible, turn off lights, silence cell phones.
- If you encounter police: follow their commands and keep your hands visible.



## FIRE EVACUATION

### EVACUATE IMMEDIATELY

- Activate nearest fire alarm.
- Proceed to nearest exit.
- Use stairs, not elevators.
- Assist persons with disabilities.
- Meet at designated rally point.



## POWER OUTAGE

- Remain calm and offer assistance if you can.
- Move to areas of natural light in the event power is restored quickly.
- Secure hazardous materials or equipment prior to evacuation.
- Remain sheltering if power outage is due to severe weather.
