In 2014 Conestoga College in Kitchener, Ontario created Jill of All Trades™, a day-long event to inspire young women in Grades 9–12 to pursue education and careers in skilled trades and apprenticeships. This event includes hands-on workshops in the motive power, industrial and construction trade sectors. These workshops are led by industry and college mentors to help young women develop a better understanding of the potential of skilled trades' careers.

Additional event highlights include facility tours, guest speakers and a VIP Breakfast. This event allows young women to participate in a comfortable setting and gain confidence, making it a memorable experience.

Owens Community College

On December 13, 2023 Owens Community College hosted the first Jill of All Trades™ event in the United States. Sixty local high school students between grades 9 and 12 attended the event and benefited from this unique experience. This program also helps to address the skilled trades workforce needs of the future. By introducing young people to non-traditional trades and apprenticeships, this collaborative endeavor allows us to send a consistent message to young people, increase college enrollment in trades and apprenticeships, retain skilled trades workers and grow capacity.

The Jill of All Trades event at Owens Community College is scheduled for October 15, 2026.

In addition to welcoming in more than 100 students from local high schools, the Owens Foundation will be awarding one student a \$1,000 scholarship to Owens in the future. It's our goal to not only expose these young individuals to futures that are possible in the STEM fields but also introduce them to the quality education and outstanding value of an Owens education.

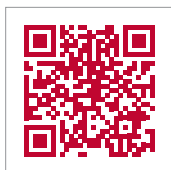
